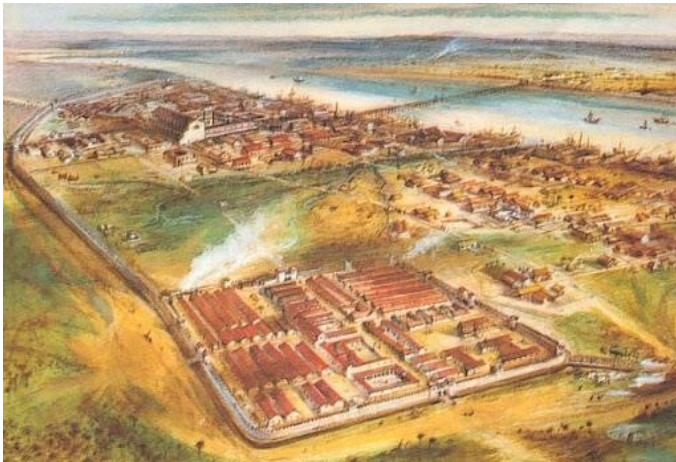

Things to do:

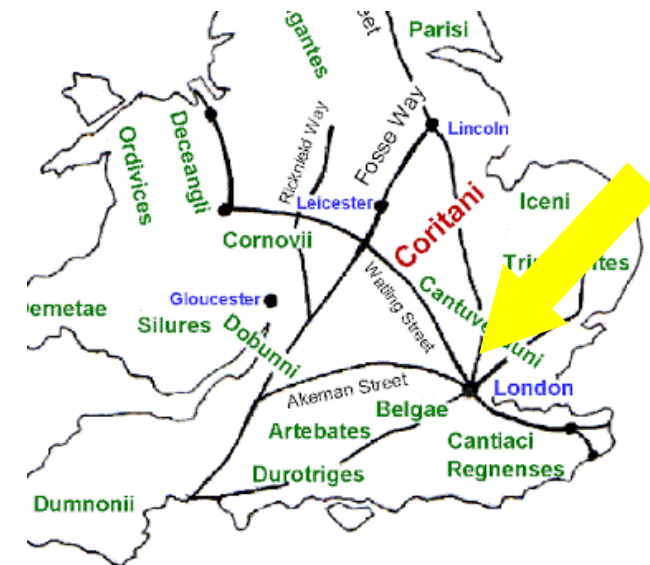
- Chill out in our beautiful Bath Houses! All you need to do is sit back, relax, and let the hot spring water melt away your aches and pains.
