Please note these comments have been paraphrased, but still represent every comment made.

You've told us		We are doing...
Praise	There were 7 comments in this section praising school and staff for the fantastic journey their child has made during their whole time at RH & the handling of the Covid-19 pandemic	We love to hear your feedback, please keep it coming.
Letters	There was 1 comment in this section suggesting letters were less repetitive and more concise	Communication is always a key to success. We will continue to do our best to limit the communication where possible.
Reports	There was 1 comment in this section suggesting more detail was needed regarding their child's progress in relation to national expectations	We are working on a new report format and how we report verbal progress to parents. This will be an item for a Parents' Forum Agenda.
Mixing classes	There was 1 comment in this section saying that their child's class had been mixed each year rather than moving up as a class	We believe there are benefits to children moving and forming new relationships, it builds resilience. However, we appreciate that some children have a different experience to others because of teachers moving around. Our class organisation page is on the school website.
School meals	There was 1 comment in this section saying that school dinners could be healthier	The school meals are produced by the Local Authority. Menus are designed by a nutritionist and I am assured that meals provide the correct balance given the price.
Sports events	There was 1 comment in this section requesting more to take place	We agree, the more we can do the better. We hope to start clubs and organise more sporting events in the future.
Transition	There was 1 comment in this section	We believe there are benefits to

handover & curriculum	stating that their child had experienced a lack of continuity with several changes of teacher within one year, poor handing over of information between these teachers and parts of the curriculum being missed	children moving and forming new relationship, it builds resilience.
