


Today's focus is inference.

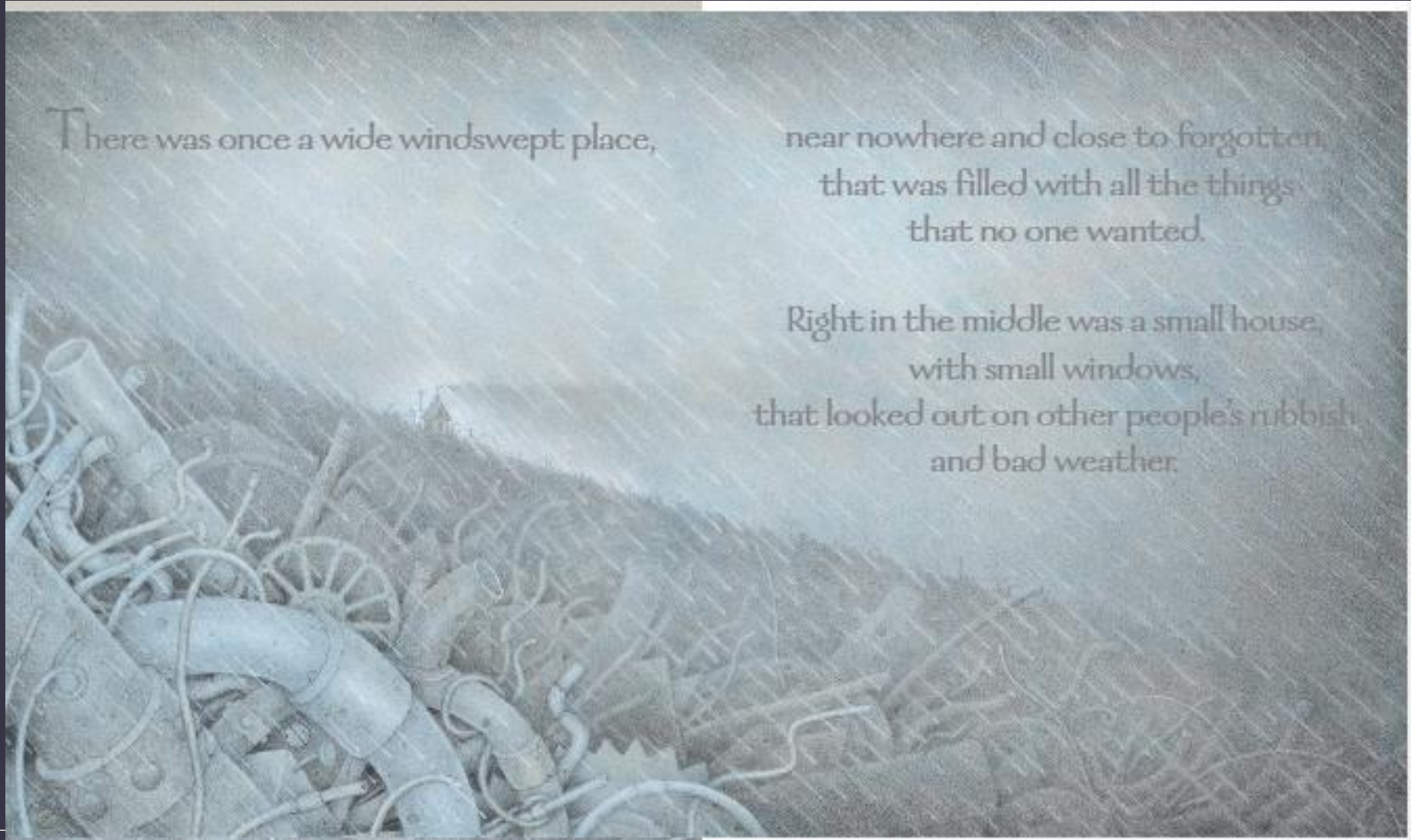
