At the click of a button you can view the school calendar and even add the dates directly into your own calendar. Absence reporting is made much easier too with quick access to our Absence Reporting Form along with all the latest school news, letters, Bulletins and Newsletters. The app also provides you with a direct means to contact the school by phone or email and a link to the school website.</p> <p>We are encouraging you to download the app to children's devices too. This will make it easier to navigate straight to our HLH. The app is FREE and is called School News and is available on all major platforms. You need to enter the school Postcode NG91AE to find and link to our school.
