<b>Thank You</b>	Thank you to all children, parents and supporters of Round Hill Primary School for all of your continued support during this half term. We will be in touch after half term as soon as any further Government advice is released about the return to school.
<b>INSET Day on 12<sup>th</sup> February</b>	A reminder that school is closed to all pupils for our INSET day this Friday 12 <sup>th</sup> February. As with a normal INSET day, staff will be receiving training about the curriculum and therefore no work will be set for children. Our online learning re-starts on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February and school re-opens to critical worker children. Staff will not be monitoring ClassDojo during half term. <b>IMPORTANT REMINDER Track and Trace over Half Term</b>	<p><b>REMINDER:</b> It is very important that parents of critical worker children / vulnerable children who have been in school continue to let us know of positive Covid-19 results even after children break up from school on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> February. Parents/Carers of critical worker children / vulnerable children who have been in school need to be ready for their child to self-isolate should someone in their school bubble test positive after Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> February.</p> <p><b>How do I Report a Positive Covid-19 Test Result? (Including during Half Term)</b></p> <p>If your child receives a positive test result, even during half term, you must complete our electronic form on the school website. The form is located on <a href="#">this link</a>. This is the same form we use for reporting daily absence. Do not leave a message on the school answerphone as this will not be monitored during half term.</p> <p>In addition, if your child is self-isolating due to a member of your household receiving a positive result, should your child subsequently develop symptoms and also test positive, please complete the form to let us know.</p> <p>If there is a need for your child to self-isolate, we will communicate with you in the usual ways, via text message and email.</p>
