Welcome Back	Welcome back to what will be a very busy half term. We hope you all had a good break during the October half term.
Communication with School	Please DO NOT use ClassDojo to communicate urgent matters with a class teacher. This is a serious safeguarding issue and children are being put at risk. For example, parents should not use ClassDojo to let teachers know about a child’s appointment, to advise if someone different is collecting a child or to let them know a child is ill. All of these messages must come directly to the School Office.
Lateness	It has been noted that some parents with children in Years 1-6 are arriving at 9.00 a.m. to drop their child off. Children are becoming upset and this causes disruption to the start of the day routines in the classroom. A late register is taken on a daily basis and noted on their school file. This is monitored by the Attendance Officer.
