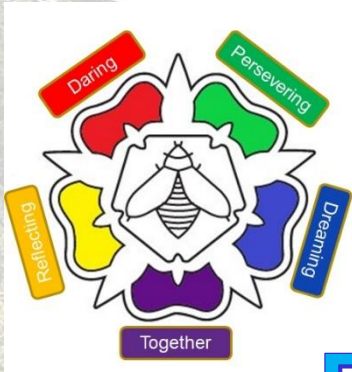

- Beaumanor Hall is a Victorian country house located in Woodhouse, Leicestershire.
- Set in 34 acres of idyllic countryside, they offer educational day visits and residential experiences as part of their educational program.
- At Beaumanor Hall, there is a large country house (where we will eat our evening meals and partake in an evening activity), classrooms, adventure playgrounds, a sports hall and many other facilities.

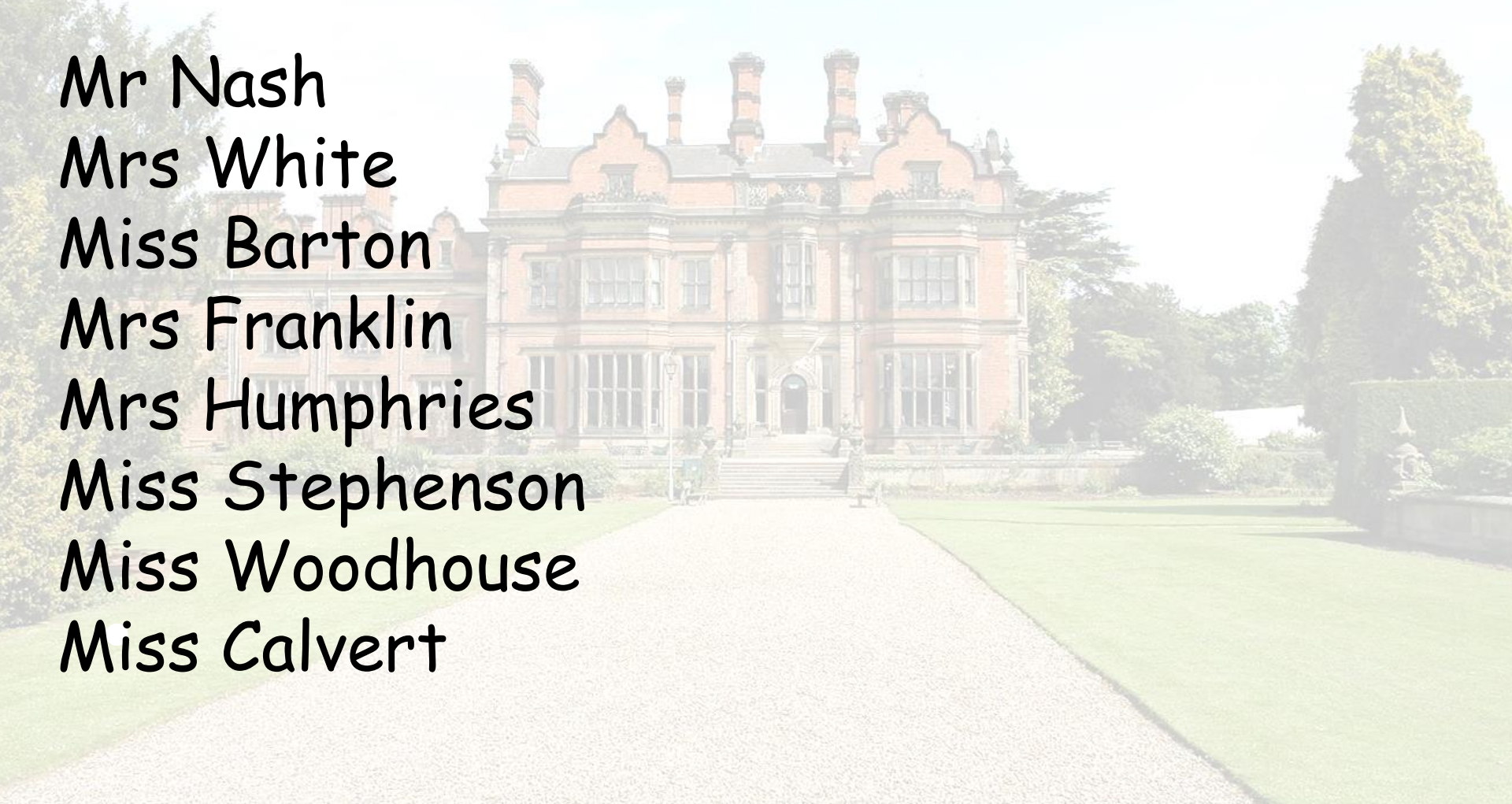

Accommodation

- During our time on the residential, we stay in cabins - not the big house, unfortunately!
- There are five cabins in total which are near to the sports hall where some of our activities take place.
- Boys and girls will be in completely separate cabins.



Accommodation

- Each cabin has a common area where children can relax and socialise before bed time.
- The cabins all have bunk beds for the children and a bathroom containing cubical toilets and cubical showers.
- Each of the cabins is equipped with a door alarm that we activate in the evenings before bed.
- If any of the external doors are opened when this alarm is activated, it sounds an alarm in the adult bedroom.

Accommodation

- Children will be given a request slip and asked to list a few people they would like to be with in their dorm and in their day group.
- We will make sure that children are with at least one of their chosen friends in the dorm and group.
- Children will find out their groups and dorms when we arrive at Beaumanor.

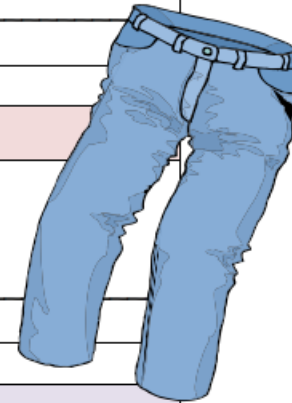

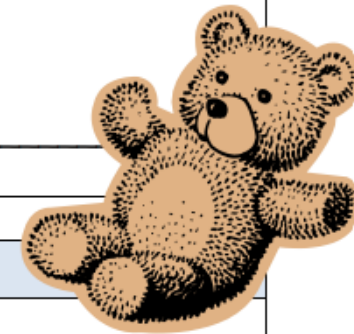

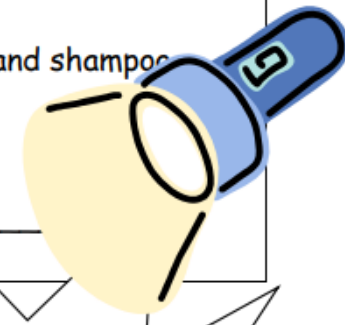
Basics

Kit list

Luggage should only be about a cabin size bag and children should be able to carry all of their luggage by themselves.

All children will need a day bag too where they can keep their water bottles etc during the activities.

Kit list

You can bring a camera if you want to, but please make sure it isn't an expensive one as it may get lost or damaged. It would be better to bring a disposable camera rather than a digital one.

Please **DON'T** bring any electronic toys or game consoles. You won't be allowed to use them and they might get damaged or lost!

You can bring a **VERY SMALL** amount of sweets (ie one packet) if you bring too many, you might find the teachers get hungry!

If you need to bring any medicines, please give them to your teacher in a sealed plastic bag labeled with your name and any instructions.

Please make sure all of your things have your name written on them!

Medical Form

- A medical form will be emailed to you tomorrow (Friday 29th September)
- This must be completed by Tuesday 3rd October.
- Everyone must complete the medical form as it contains important information about your child and your contact information should we need it.
- Medication should be handed to the Class teacher or Miss Stephenson on the morning of 18th October
- Please ensure that medicines are inside a named plastic bag, in original packaging and that the label includes timings and dosages.

Important reminders

- Please can all medication be handed in to your child's class teacher in a labelled sandwich bag on the Wednesday morning. This includes travel sickness medication for our return.
- Please make sure that **ALL** clothes are labelled.
- **No electronic toys, mobile phones or smart devices etc. are allowed.**
- **No sweets or chocolate for the bus journey please!**
- A maximum of £5 can be taken as pocket money - this needs to be in a purse or wallet and is the responsibility of your child (£1 coins are preferable).
