## **Year 2 Camp 2024**

We are delighted to announce that we will be inviting all Year 2 children to an overnight Year 2 Camp on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2024. The Year 2 camp will be led by the KS1 team and we will also be joined by Mr. Nash. The school camp is a fun and exciting experience for the children and provides great opportunities for them to develop their team work and social skills. The children will also get the chance to meet and spend time with some of the Year 3/4 teachers as they will be leading and participating in some of the activities.

### **Timings**

The children will leave school at the normal time of 3.30 p.m. on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July and have their dinner at home. They will then return to school at their allotted time.

Foxes:	5.25 p.m. to 5.30 p.m.
Rabbits:	5.30 p.m. to 5.35 p.m.
Otters:	5.35 p.m. to 5.40 p.m.
Hedgehogs:	5.40 p.m. to 5.45 p.m.
Badgers:	5.45 p.m. to 5.50 p.m.

The next morning, the children will wake up, wash, clean their teeth and change into fresh clothing. They will then have breakfast in the school hall with all of the other Year 2 children. It is important that you notify us of any dietary requirements via the online form. We are asking for a voluntary donation of £2.00 towards the cost of the breakfast items. The money can be handed in directly to your child's class teacher.

For the rest of the school day, your child will be participating in lots of fun camp-related activities with their class teacher. The children will be dismissed in the usual way at 3.30 p.m.

### **Health/Medical**

In order for your child to attend the camp, we ask that all parents/carers complete the below confidential parental consent form as soon as possible or by the end of Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April at the latest. This is to allow us time to plan accordingly:

We also ask that you let us know of any special dietary requirements. Please note that there will be a fully qualified first aider attending the camp at all times.

### **Kit List**

Year 2 Camp kit list:

- Night clothes – A pair of pyjamas or something to wear to go to sleep in
- Towel – The children will have a wash in school in the morning
- Toiletries – Toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush etc.
- Warm clothes for playing outside – A jumper and tracksuit bottoms
- A waterproof coat
- A warm sleeping bag
- A roll mat
- A pillow
- Trainers for outdoor activities
- Water bottle

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**Optional:**

- A cuddly toy for bedtime
- A book/magazine for bedtime reading
- A torch

Please do not bring any electrical items or other toys and please do not send your child with any sweets, snacks or drinks.

We appreciate that not all parents will be able to attend this meeting, so any information provided will be put on the school website. However, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher if you have any questions or queries.

We would love it if all of our Year 2 children take part in this exciting experience. Thank you for helping to make Round Hill school camp a success.
