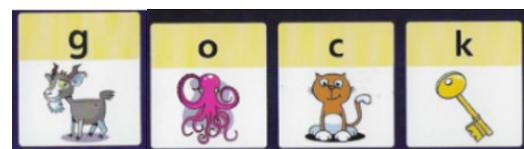
## Literacy
