

The songs are great to help children remember the names of numerals and we have included great visuals to encourage children's recognition of different numbers. Some children have also wowed us with their understanding of what is happening in the song, explaining that one is taken away each time so there is less.

We have been rhyming crazy in literacy using our book of the week to help us.

Children have been using their listening skills from phonics and their understanding of the story to recognise rhyming words and play around with them to make silly stories.


