Spring Term 1

Now that you've been shown you can practise on your own.

This half term is based all around a growth mind-set and never give up attitude. Using the well known story, Zog, we will be looking at what it means to persevere and not give up in the face of a challenge. Children will be challenging themselves in all areas of the curriculum and look at different ways to push themselves out of their comfort zone. We will also be learning about key events that fall in this half term including, Lunar Year and Internet Safety Day.

Communication and Language

We will continue to look at key vocabulary from our 'Book of the Week' - looking at the meaning and synonyms of the words. Many of the words will relate to challenge and a persevering attitude towards something children cannot 'yet' do. We will be developing our ability to explain our ideas in full sentences to our peers and build upon ideas as part of a group.

Personal, Social and Emotional

Growth mind-set, challenging self, not giving up and pushing self out of our comfort zones is at the forefront of this half time. We will start the half term talking about how practise helps us get better at something. We will then be talking about how finding something hard or being out of our comfort zone can make us feel. We will be doing this through various texts and social stories

Physical Development

In P.E, we will having a big focus on gross motor skills and the movement of our whole body to music. Children will be exposed to many different styles and tempos of music as well as given the chance to explore their own movements and take ideas from others. Children will also be encouraged to mirror choreographed movements to learn how to move to a beat .

Literacy

Our Books of the Week will continue.... Starting with the well known favourite Zog. We will use the text to recall things Zog found tricky but when he showed perseverance was able to achieve something he once found hard. We will be encouraging 'He can...' sentences which we will then transfer over to the first person, to write ' I can.....' sentences.

Maths

We will be starting the half term looking at the composition on zero and what makes zero. We will be talking about different words that describe zero. We will look at the composition of numbers to 5 and then look at numbers up to 10 along with counting forwards and backwards. We will be ordering numbers and looking at the patterns within numbers .

Expressive Arts and Design

There is going to be a big focus on various artists and illustrators this term. Children have already been exposed to what an artist is and a well know Artist, Alma Thomas, from the beginning of this half term. We will be building upon this by not only looking at different artists but also talking about what we notice within their art work and illustrations.
