Summer Term 1

Just Keep Digging

Each half term is based around one of our school values. This half term is based around the reflecting petal where we will be exploring what is happening around us in our environment and compare it to last half term as we transition from winter to spring and into summer. We will also be looking at different lifecycles and how different animals transform from one thing to another. This includes tadpoles, plants, butterflies and chickens.

Communication and Language

This half term will be bursting with language and new vocabulary for children to use. Building on from last half term, children will be extending their sentences and ideas as we encourage them to sequence their thinking when talking about different topics and observations. Using our topic of lifecycles and growing will help children to talk about the different experiences they are having throughout.

Personal, Social and Emotional

This half term is based around RSE with a key focus around relationships and how we can communicate different feelings that we may face around those relationships. Using our friendly puppet Ezza, children will be exploring how to handle conflict with a friend and what to do when they feel sad. We will also be looking at different ways that people express how they are feeling.

Physical Development

This half term will end with sports day. In preparation for this children will be learning how to run down a track and stay in their lane. We will be talking about what it means to work as a team as well as being competitive in a race situation. We will also be practising some fundamental movement skills including running, jumping, skipping and balancing.

Literacy

Our books of the week—please see below, will be leading the way to ensuring children are filled with subject specific and rich vocabulary that they can use to explain their thinking, ideas and observations. There will be a focus on the skill of sequencing stories and scheme, such as lifecycles as well as continuing to development children's ability to break down the speech into words.

Maths

.This half term there will be a big focus on number. We will start the half term by revisiting the concepts of number bonds from 4 to 10 using part, part, whole models and ten frames as this is something we feel children needed more of. This will lead us onto the remainder of the term where we will build on this knowledge to count on from 5 and start double and halving numbers.

Expressive Arts and Design

This half term is all around printing with different resources to explore pattern and texture. Using objects around us and fruits and vegetables, children will print onto paper and into dough. Children will also be encouraged to take part in observational drawings of trees, flowers and nature with the goal of refining their drawings and detail over time.
