This week has been all about Shrove Tuesday and making pancakes. Our book of the week has been replaced with a simple step of instructions to help us make a pancake. This has led to many things including children writing their own recipes, designing their own pancake toppings and having a go for themselves.

Maths

This week we have been starting to look at number bonds and different variations of number bonds for the numbers 4, 5, and 6. Children have been learning how to use part, part, whole diagrams to represent the total amount and how it can be split into parts. We have been recording our answers using a number sentence.

Literacy
