



Maths

This week we have been looking at positional language such as forward, backwards, in front, behind, on top and underneath.

Children have been following instructions outside to complete an obstacle course and making up their own instruction using positional language.

Using the story Rosie's Walk, children have also been designing maps and talking about where the different things are positioned.

Literacy
