Dare to be Different

Each half term is based around one of our school values. This half term is based around the Daring petal on the Round Hill Rose. Building on last half term's theme, Perseverance, we will be pushing ourselves to think outside of the box to make or do something new or different. Our perseverance skills will come in handy as we may need to try and try again until we get there but we will never give up.

Communication and Language

We will be encouraging children to explain their ideas in a structured manner. We will be talking about how different things work, about ideas and how we came to them as well as talking about what went wrong along the way. Using our Books of the Week, we will be encouraging children to use new vocabulary within their speech and inspiring them to express themselves in front of groups.

Personal, Social and Emotional

This half term will involve lots of perseverance and the theme will continue to run through everything we do. From planning a project to having a go at making it, we will try and try again.

We will also be working in groups and expressing our ideas to each other. Additionally, we will be celebrating ourselves and thinking about what makes us unique and wonderful.

Physical Development

This half term is based around gymnastics. The children will start the half term exploring how to extend their limbs showing extension and control. We will be looking at the different ways we can move our bodies at different levels and looking at moving from one level to another with control. During the second half of the half term, we will be balancing across equipment and rocking and rolling.

Literacy

Literacy is taking a twist this half term as we start it off looking at sequencing a set of instructions. The focus will initially be on making pancakes but the skills will be applied to making a wing for our class crow as the half term unfolds. Children will be using pencil control to draw and design firstly a wing for a crow who cannot fly, and then an invention of their choice.

Maths

We will start the half term continuing to look at numbers and patterns within them. We will be exploring number bonds from 2—10 and recording what we know using number sentences. Children will be using part, part, whole diagrams to split different amounts into two groups. Children will also be using colours and shapes to make and explore complex repeating patterns.

Expressive Arts and Design

Following the theme of instructions and birds, children will be following step by step instructions to draw a bird. We will be looking at different artists including Jackson Pollock and Richard Allen. We will be expressing ourselves in different ways, including using our bodies and voices to make music and moving our bodies in different ways.
