<b>Literacy Lessons</b>	We would like to let you all know, that in line with our plans for continued school improvement, we are no longer going to be doing 'Let's Write' sessions on a Friday. Let's Write will be replaced by literacy lessons that lead up to and support independent writing. Pieces of writing will still be authored but through a slower process which will allow pupils a greater opportunity to receive support and feedback as they write. They will also have a greater opportunity to review and improve their work. There will no longer be the traditional, weekly, Let's Talk Homework although you may be asked to talk about ideas and writing with your child.
<b>Fortnite Letter</b>	You will have received a letter this week regarding the online battle game Fortnite. In the letter I explained that we have become aware of an increasing number of children across KS2 playing the popular online battle arena game Fortnite. I would be very grateful if you could take the time to read the letter and discuss the contents with your child. Thank you for your help.
<b>School Start Times</b>	<p>Please ensure your child is at school on time every day. EYFS children start at 9.00 a.m. and should enter through the gates on the small playground.
