Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for your patience in this, another unprecedented situation we find ourselves in, none of us expected to be here again, but as always we will be on hand to help where we can.

Further to the letter I sent on [4th January](#), as promised I write today to confirm the details for continued home learning provision up until February half term.

The work for each day can be found on the school website in a newly created tab '[Home/School Blended Learning - Spring Term 2021](#)'. Some children will need to be supported to access the work for that day. In this new way of working, it is important that children do not race ahead and only complete the work for that day. If children want to do more, there are other links to additional work if they need them. We have a list of parents who said they cannot access online learning materials and we will be in touch with an offer of support and/or a 'workpack' in the next few days.

The website also contains lots of support materials which can be found by [clicking here](#). These include how to support your child with home learning, ideas to support their mental health and what to do if you need help yourself.

Free School Meals (FSM)

We anticipate that the Government will again be providing vouchers for children who are in receipt of FSM. I do not know how this will work yet but will be in touch again when I do.

Workbooks/Items left in School

Your child may have left items in school yesterday, unless they are essential items then please leave them in school and we will keep them safe until your child returns. However, if the items are critical then we are offering for them to be collected from the entrance hall in the next few days as part of your daily exercise. I will write again with more details however this will take place on Thursday and Friday this week.

If you need paper or blank books to write in, there will a box in the entrance hall where you can collect one for free, you can add a donation to local charity if you want to.
