What you need:

- A dragon whistle
- A collar
- Plenty of food
- Dragon's den.
- Bucket of water

Let's reread the instructions.

What you do:

1. First, collect dragon food such as: mice, rats and the bodies of other lesser creatures. You must make sure to avoid giving the Yellow Bottom Dragon any vegetables as this can give them hideous hiccups that last two weeks.
2. Next, lay the dragon feast on a flat rock. Make sure the rock you choose has enough room for your creature to lie next to it as this is the Yellow Bottom Dragon's favourite position when eating.
3. After that, provide a bucket of water as dragons always like to drink after eating.
4. Then, retire to a safe distance before letting your pet out for its dinner. Remember that a hungry dragon may well mistake you for its next meal so a simple disguise is essential...
5. Finally, keep your pet lodged in a simple dragon's den. These have to be custom-made and can be purchased at your local 'Dragons R Us' store. They should be made of fireproof material. At first you may keep a very young dragon in the house, but as it grows larger, you will have to find an outdoor spot as a sleeping dragon will snore
