Introduces the information that comes after it

Apostrophe



Used to show possession or for contraction of word.

The name of companies:

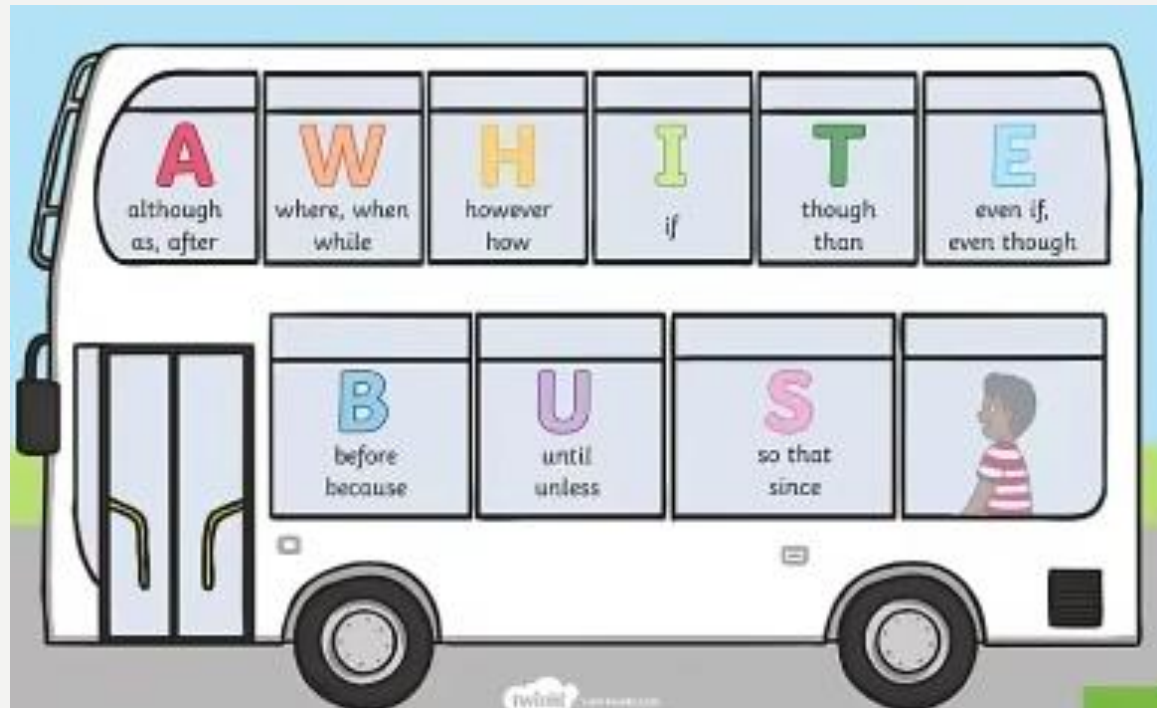
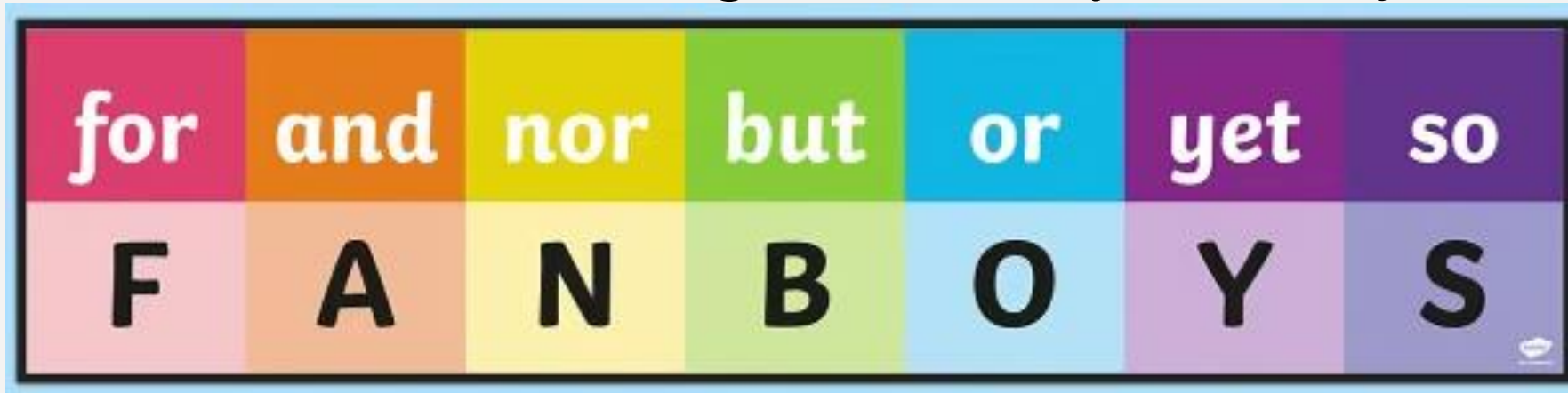
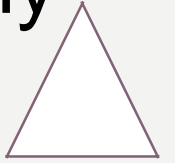


They are also used at the beginning of sentences:
