


Key Information about the Yellow Bottom Dragon:

Below is how to prevent this from happening.

What you need:

- Å dragon whistle
- A collar
- Plenty of food.
- Dragon's den.
- Bucket of water



What you do:

- First, collect dragon food such as: mice, rats and the bodies of other lesser creatures. You must make sure to avoid giving the Yellow Bottom Dragon any vegetables as this can give them hideous hiccups that last two weeks.
- Next, lay the dragon feast on a flat rock. Make sure the rock you choose has enough room for your creature to lie next to it as this is the Yellow Bottom Dragon's favourite position when eating.
