### COVID-19 Update - No Action Needed

We were made aware yesterday evening that two members of staff at school have tested positive for COVID-19 using Lateral Flow Tests. Both members of staff have now also taken a full Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test and they have also proved positive. We do not believe the two cases are related.

After carrying out our own track and trace procedures, we have taken advice and have identified the adults/children that are affected after being in close contact with the members of staff. We made contact with the parents of 16 pupils last night to let them know that their child must now self-isolate.

We know that you may find this concerning but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with Public Health England. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

A reminder that if your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, please let us know via email, [office@roundhill.notts.sch.uk](mailto:office@roundhill.notts.sch.uk). This email is monitored in the evenings, at weekends and over half term. Children should remain at home for at least 10 days from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for testing and this can be arranged via <https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test> or by calling 119.
