Safe Internet Use

Ofsted require us to judge the impact of doing safe internet use with the children. It was agreed to put an item in the Newsletter and then ask the children in a couple of months to find out what impact it had.

Curriculum Policy. JH said the curriculum policy was a cross over with the Teaching and Learning Policy. We are at the development stage of the curriculum leadership - it may be another year yet before this is all tied up with the middle leaders. It is in the SEF as an issue and has an action plan

Transition to Secondary School

RP reported that the link with Alderman White (AW) is smoother now. We now have advance dates for transition visits which need to be given to parents. More clubs have been set up e.g. gifted and talented. Year 7 children have been to talk to our year 6 children. We want to improve the handover information at the end of the year. A teacher from AW comes each week to teach French. SEN children are taken to AW by our Teaching Assistants and are supported by our SENCo.
