



## Round Hill Bulletin 10: 24<sup>th</sup> March 2021

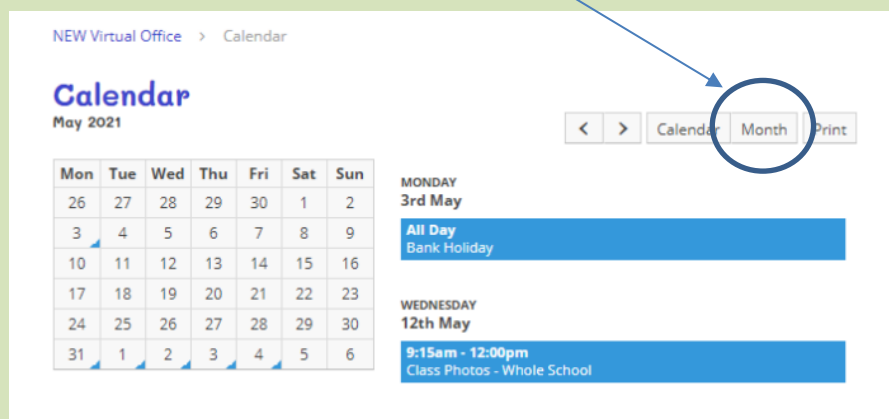

	Whole School Information
<b>Thank you from Mr Nash</b>	This is our last School Bulletin before we break up for the Easter Holidays next Thursday 1 <sup>st</sup> April. Thank you for your support with the safe return of all children to school during this half term. It is lovely to have everyone back at school.
<b>Next Inset Day – Monday 19<sup>th</sup> April</b>	<p>A reminder that our next Inset Day is on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> April when school is open to staff only. We will look forward to seeing all children back at school after the Easter break on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> April.</p> <p>A reminder that the final inset day is on Monday 7th June.</p>
<b>Confirmed Case of Covid-19</b>	We have today had a confirmed case of Covid-19 for a teacher at Round Hill. The class bubble and any other affected children were contacted first thing this morning and will now be self-isolating until the end of the day on Friday 2 <sup>nd</sup> April.
<b>Keeping Children Off School if Unwell</b>	<p>As we approach the Easter holidays, to help us minimise the spread of any illnesses in school, we are urging parents to keep their child off school if they are unwell in any way. Now that testing is increasingly available I would urge you not to hesitate, if your child is displaying any Covid-19 symptoms, to get a PCR test.</p> <p>We appreciate that it is very difficult to tell whether your child may have a cold or a symptom of Covid-19 and therefore we ask that you err on the side of caution if your child is unwell at all. Please complete the <a href="#">Absence Form</a> on the school website for each day of absence to keep us informed of the reason for absence. A reminder that if your child does have any Covid-19 symptoms then they will need to have negative result from a Covid-19 Test before they are able to return to school.</p>
<b>Test and Trace over the Easter Holidays</b>	<p>It is very important that parents continue to let us know of positive Covid-19 results even after we break up on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April. Parents/Carers need to be ready for their child to self-isolate should someone in their school bubble test positive after we break up.</p> <p><b>How do I Report a Positive Covid-19 Test Result? (Including During the Holiday)</b> If your child receives a positive test result, even in the school holiday, you must complete our electronic <a href="#">Absence Form</a> on the school website. This is the same Absence Form we use for reporting daily absence. Do not leave a message on the school answerphone nor ClassDojo as this will not be monitored during the Easter holiday period.</p> <p>In addition, if your child is self-isolating due to a member of your household receiving a positive result, should your child subsequently develop symptoms and also test positive, please complete the <a href="#">Absence Form</a> to let us know.</p> <p><b>How will you let us know if there is a positive test case when we are not at school?</b> If there is a need for your child to self-isolate, we will communicate with you in the usual ways, via text message and email.</p>
<b>Class Dojo Communications</b>	An important letter was sent out earlier today related to communication via ClassDojo. Please take the time to read this letter so that, now we have returned to school, you know how we are using ClassDojo. <a href="#">Click here</a> to read the letter on the school website.
<b>School Diary Dates</b>	We have finalised the <a href="#">dates for the summer term</a> and in doing so we have planned some events to enable a degree of normality to return. As I am sure will you appreciate certain events will not be able to take place for obvious reasons and we have struggled to fit everything into the school term after the planned removal of restrictions on 21 <sup>st</sup> June.

Please note that all dates are provisional. If dates do have to change at short notice this may be beyond our control. We will always explain why an event has been cancelled or postponed and give you as much notice as possible.
