Y5/6 Expectations and Information

- * To set the example to the rest of the school.
- * To have an 'I can' attitude and to embrace new challenges.
- * To develop higher levels of responsibility by: remembering PE kits, planners and all equipment needed for class each day/week.

PE Kit



- * Your child needs to come in their PE Kit on their designated PE day.
- * We will let you know on Class Dojo which day this is.
- * PE Kits should be weather appropriate because we will be outside where possible.

Homework & planners



- * Homework and Spellings will be available on TEAMS.
- * Children will be encouraged to read at home – every day if possible!
- * Planners are extremely important and will be needed in class every day!

Residential & Production



- * We hope the Year 6 children will be going on their Residential Trip to Kingswood. These dates will be 11th – 15th October. More information will follow in the Autumn Term.
- * We also hope that the Year 6 production will go ahead in the Summer Term.
- * We are also planning for an additional day trip for all children.

The Pound Project



- * This is a Year 6 project that enables the children to develop their understanding of finance, budgets and teamwork.
- * Each child is given a pound once they have had their initial money raising plan approved.
- * They are encouraged to 'pool' their money and work together.
- * They will be raising money throughout the year including the Christmas and Summer fairs, should they go ahead.
- * At the end of the year all the money will be counted and the children will decide together how they want to spend it. In the past the children have purchased school hoodies or gone on a trip.
- * There will also be a choice of charity donation or a legacy to leave behind.

Cycling Proficiency



- * This will take place for Year 6s, delivered by the Bikeability team.
- * We will let you know when it is going to take place as soon as we can.
- * You will be responsible for ensuring your bike is ready. The summer would be a great time to do this!



SATs...



- * During May, the Year 6 children will be doing SATs.
- * The tests will take place over one week.
- * They will be tested on Reading, Maths, Spelling and Grammar.
- * Year 5 learning will still continue whilst SATs take place.

Maths



- * As has happened this year, Maths will be taught in single age year groups.
- * Any Year 6 specific events (such as the pound project and production rehearsals) will primarily happen during these times to ensure Year 5 learning is not disrupted.

Rewards System



- * Children will be rewarded with one of five vision petals throughout the week.
- * Children will receive a Bronze, Silver or Gold sticker depending on how many petals are gained each week.
- * Children will be congratulated on their achievements in class.
- * Each class also has their own system of rewards.
