

Homework tasks: Autumn 1 Kings and Queens

This half term, we are going to give you control over what homework you complete! You will need to practise your spellings, times tables, My Maths and read and record regularly in your planner. You will need to choose a **minimum of 3 tasks** to complete from the topic grid and post your photos on class dojo by the final week of half term. Each task is worth the amount of dojos below.

There will be dojo points for any extra tasks you complete!

Literacy: Practise your spellings for the week. Remember, we learn best when we understand *how* to use each word so try to use the ones you find most tricky in a sentence. Read and record in your planner at least 3 times per week.

Maths: Practise your times tables so that you are ready for your next test! Try and spend some time weekly on TTs Rockstars.

Complete the My Maths tasks that you have been set by your teacher. On a week when My Maths has not been set, practice your KIRFs at home.

Find out 5 facts about Buckingham Palace. 1 dojo	Design a crown fit for a King or Queen 1 dojo	People love to paint portraits of Monarchs. Draw/paint a portrait of Queen Elizabeth II 1 dojo
Monarchs have their own coat of arms. Research some coats of arms and then design your own. 2 dojos	Dress up as a King or Queen. Have your photo taken and write a caption to go with it. 2 dojos	Design a poster about what Henry VIII liked to eat and drink. 2 dojos
Imagine you are King or Queen for the day. Write a letter to the public to tell them what new rules you will bring in. 3 dojos	Make a 3D model of a castle or palace. 3 dojos	Choose one British Monarch from history to research and write a fact file about them. 3 dojos
