<p>Children Continually Arriving Late to School</p>	<p>I have written to parents on numerous occasions about arriving at school on time and now feel that further action must be taken. Children who arrive after everyone else, start their day feeling anxious and upset, and further disrupt their learning. This must stop.</p> <p>Please know that this is not directed at the vast majority of parents, but I write this in hope that this is a final chance to solve this issue before I take matters further with specific families.</p> <p>Last entry onto the large playground is 8:55 a.m. as this allows time to walk to the class and parents to exit the site by 9:00 a.m. when the gates are locked. Entry after 8:55 a.m. will be refused and parents will have to take their child to the front entrance. Records are kept of all children who arrive late, but only acted upon when this keeps recurring.</p> <p>I know the vast majority of you will support me in this approach and please be assured that it is only the regular offenders that the strategy is aimed at.</p>
