Year 4 Residential Trip to Ilam Hall, 7th-9th June 2023



Staffing

- The trip will be attended by: Miss Waterall, Mr Nash, Miss King, Mrs Davies, Miss Woodhouse, Miss Hodgkiss and Mrs Hornsby.
- All activities are run by the Ilam Hall staff who are extremely experienced and vetted.
- These activities include orienteering, map reading and science experiments.

Medication

- If your child has any medication, for example inhalers etc, it is essential that they are brought in a **sealed, named bag with clear dosage protocols** and given directly to the member of staff at the First Aid stand.
- Please do not send your child with any medication you have not previously informed the school about e.g. Hay fever tablets or Travel sickness tablets

Wednesday Morning

- When your child arrives at school at the normal time, they must put their bags in the hall.
- Please ensure your child is not late on this day!
- Please ensure all bags and belongings are clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Please do not allow your child to bring any sweets for the trip!
- We will then leave via coach at approximately
 9:30 to arrive at around 12:00.

Wednesday

- Your child will need to bring a packed lunch in a rucksack with them and will eat this once we arrive at Ilam Hall. They should also have a coat with them. They will then meet the centre staff and begin their first afternoon activity.
- Orienteering or River Study 1:30-4:30pm
- Bed Making Children will be expected to put their own bed sheets on (They may need a bit of practise at home beforehand)
- Evening meal at 5:30pm.
- Evening activity: Egg Rockets or Environmental Art
- Bedtime at 9.00pm

Thursday Morning

• Breakfast at 7:45am

 Guided walk to Dovedale/ Team building challenges 9:00am

Packed lunch at 12.00 provided by the centre.

Thursday Afternoon

 Afternoon activity- Team building challenges/ Guided walk to Dovedale

• Evening meal at 5:30pm

 Evening activity: Egg Rockets or Environmental Art

• Bedtime at 9pm.

Friday Morning

- Breakfast at 7:45am
- Activity, River Study and orienteering.
- Packed lunch and then departure back to school at 1pm.
- If we are delayed, we will contact school who will then send a text out via the school system to inform all Year 4 parents.
- You will collect your child (and bags!) at normal time at 3:35pm.

Trip kit letter

- Your child should bring two bags; A day bag with their lunch in and anything they will need during Wednesday, a bigger bag with the rest of their belongings.
- Children should have at least three pairs of shoes; slippers or similar for indoors, outdoor waterproof shoes, wellingtons or walking boots.

Trip kit letter

- The letter details the kit your child will need for Ilam Hall. Please label <u>all</u> kit.
- A majority of the time will be spent outdoors and so warm, water-proof clothes will be essential!
- There will be an opportunity to get an ice cream at Dovedale and so while your child is welcome to bring the recommended pocket money, they should not bring more than £3. Please have this labelled with your child's name. Teachers will collect all money at school before leaving and will look after this until the children need to use

Your child will 'probably' get dirty so DO NOT pack new or decent clothes for this trip!

The following items need to be packed into a sensible bag/suitcase, which can be carried by your child:

- Wash bag including toothbrush, toothpaste, soap etc
- Towel
- Pyjamas/nightie
- Socks and underwear (NB. We suggest that children have enough socks to be able to wear 2 pairs with wellies).
- 3 t-shirts/shirts
- 2 sweatshirts/jumpers
- 2 pairs of trousers tracksuit bottoms/casual trousers etc
- 1 pair of jeans (for casual/hall use)
- Plastic bags for dirty/wet clothes
- Trainers/strong outdoor robust footwear (two pairs, one for indoor and one for outdoor use)
- Walking shoes if you have them strong comfortable shoes if not.
- Wellies
- Hat, gloves (just in case we hope we don't need them!)
- Suncream depending on weather!
- Waterproof Jacket
- A book for those quiet moments!
- Water bottle
- You will also need to provide a packed lunch for the first day.

Please make sure that the clothes are labelled. **No electronic toys, mobile phones or ipods etc. are allowed. No sweets or chocolate for the bus journey please!** A maximum of £5 can be taken as pocket money – this needs to be in a named purse or wallet and will be handed to teachers before leaving school. Disposable cameras can be taken but again are the responsibility of the children.
