What Will Teachers Talk About?

Teachers will talk about your child's continuing progress including their relationships with others and how together we can ensure they achieve their best. We will also talk about the next steps in learning and the way in which you can help at home. We firmly believe that learning at Round Hill Primary School should be filled with creative opportunities and not just about academic progress. We will always place emphasis on children having fun and learning through a varied curricular experience.

Research shows that feedback has the biggest impact on children's learning and we strongly believe that having your child involved in the conversation will assist in their continued progress.
