Spring Term Focus E-Safety (Online Safety)	I wrote to parents in Year 5/6 a couple of weeks ago following several widespread incidents in which children have been abusing social media platforms. Parents of younger children may find it useful to read the letter and view the new and updated pages I have created on the school website. It has an essential guide for parents about children using WhatsApp and also guidance leaflets on TikTok, Snapchat and even the need to know safety on using Smart Watches.  There will be a regular item in each Bulletin about an E-Safety issue. This term the Hot Topic is WhatsApp. Are you sure you know exactly who your child in chatting to online? Does your child ever share their location with anyone? If you are not 100% positive, then this leaflet talks about the safeguards parents need to have in place when allowing their children to use this form of Social Media. Equals Trust Update	You may remember I wrote to parents on 19th December 2023 with an update on our conversion to academy status and the formal joining of Equals Trust. The official conversion date depends on collaboration between the Local Authority and the Regional Schools Commissioner. This date has been rescheduled several times due the volume of work at the Local Authority. Whilst we anticipated being part of Equals Trust by now, the latest scheduled date for conversion is 1st August 2024 (previously 1st May 2024).		
	It is worth remembering that Round Hill has informally been involved with Equals Trust for some time now. We have continued to access their resources and support systems, ensuring access to the most current advice, guidance, and enrichment events for our pupils.
