The show will take place at Djanogly Theatre, Lakeside Arts, University Park, Nottingham, NG7 2RD and we have secured tickets across three performances to accommodate all KS1 classes:

- **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> December at 10.30 a.m. – Hedgehogs & Year 2 Rabbits**
- **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> December at 1.30 p.m. – Otters, Badgers & Year 1 Rabbits**
- **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> December at 1.30 p.m. – Foxes**

This is a fantastic opportunity for children to experience live theatre and celebrate the festive season together. The show is created especially for younger audiences and supports our wider curriculum by nurturing imagination, storytelling, and shared cultural experiences.

The cost of the trip is £11.10 per child. This includes the theatre ticket and return travel on the tram.
