Year 6 (current Year 5's) Beaumanor Hall Residential: Monday 9th November - Wednesday 11th November 2026

We are excited to confirm that we are organising a three-day Year 6 residential trip at Beaumanor Hall, Leicestershire, in November 2026 for the next cohort of Year 6 pupils. The residential trip will run from Monday 9th November to Wednesday 11th November 2026.

Beaumanor Hall is a leading residential activity centre provider, responsible for delivering safe and rewarding educational programmes. By combining many National Curriculum linked modules with thrilling outdoor and indoor adventure activities, this trip is sure to provide your child with a wealth of new experiences outside of the classroom while developing key learning outcomes. Beaumanor Hall offers a vast range of activities to develop children's self-confidence and teamwork skills. During this trip, children will experience activities such as high ropes, zip wire, canoeing, shelter building, survival skills and archery. In the evenings, children also partake in entertainment activities.

Residential trips organised by school are an optional but invaluable part of the Round Hill Curriculum. In previous years, our pupils have benefitted hugely from the Year 6 residential experience, both educationally and socially.
