Dear Parents/Carers with a child in Year 2,

We are delighted to invite all Year 2 children to take part in an overnight Camp at school on Thursday 2nd July 2026.

The camp will be led by our KS1 team, and Mr Nash will also be joining us. This exciting experience offers a wonderful opportunity for children to build confidence, develop teamwork and strengthen their social skills in a fun and supportive environment. During the camp, children will also have the chance to meet and spend time with some of the Year 3 teachers, who will be leading and taking part in a variety of activities.

Timings

On Thursday 2nd July, children will leave school at the normal time of 3.30 p.m. to have dinner at home before returning to school at their allocated time:

- **Foxes:** 5.25 p.m. – 5.30 p.m.
- **Hedgehogs:** 5.30 p.m. – 5.35 p.m.
- **Rabbits:** 5.35 p.m. – 5.40 p.m.

The following morning, the children will wake up, wash, brush their teeth, and change into fresh clothing. They will then enjoy breakfast together in the school hall with the rest of the Year 2 children.

Please ensure you inform us of any dietary requirements via the form below. We are asking for a voluntary donation of £2.00 to help cover the cost of breakfast items; this can be given directly to your child's class teacher.

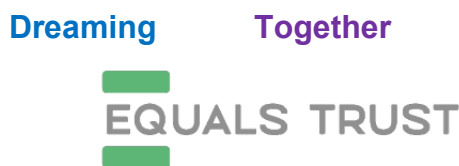
For the remainder of the day, children will take part in a range of fun, camp-related activities with their class teacher. All children will be dismissed as usual at 3.30 p.m.
