We are very excited to share some exciting news and EYFS will soon be welcoming some very special guests!

Next half term is called 'Just Keep Digging!' During this time, we will be exploring and comparing the life cycles of chicks, ducklings, butterflies and plants. As part of this, we will have the opportunity to watch ducklings hatch from their eggs and then look after them for a two-week period. During this time, the children will be able to see the eggs in the incubator and watch each duckling hatch. We will then observe, day by day, the changes the ducklings go through as they begin to grow.
