



BE A GERM DETECTIVE



MISSION To find out where those germs are hiding and stop them before you spread them on to others.

DETECTIVE WORK You can come into contact with germs wherever you go; they hide in bathrooms, kitchens, outside, at home and at school. Become a detective and for an hour go undercover and hunt the germs down. Watch everything that you do and everywhere you go to see where you can pick up germs.

WHAT TO DO During your hour as being a germ detective you need to make notes on anywhere that you go and what you do. See where you may have picked up germs, such as door handles or stroking your pet. Then see where you went next and where you may have passed these germs to.

REMEMBER
It is only some of the germs and bacteria that are bad and will make you sick; most of the germs that you come into contact with won't make you sick. The best way to keep away the bad germs is to wash your hands to keep them clean!
