Dear Parents/Carers,

Pupil Premium Funding

Pupil Premium Funding is funding from the government which is given to support some children to succeed in their school life in a number of ways. Pupil Premium Funding **must be applied for by parents/carers**.

As mentioned in the EYFS welcome meeting, families who are eligible for funding will receive a free laptop and their child will continue to receive free school meals throughout their time in primary education. There may also be other benefits such as subsidised musical instrument tuition.

Your child may be eligible for the additional Pupil Premium Funding along with Free School Meals if you receive:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on- paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Universal Credit- your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

OR your child is a looked after child, has been adopted or has a special guardianship order (inform the school)

OR a parent is Armed Services Personnel (inform the School).

It is important that if your family is eligible for Free School Meals, that Pupil Premium Funding is applied for through the Nottinghamshire County Council Online Citizen Portal. **This is not same as Universal Infant Free School Meals which are free school meals for all children in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2.**

How to apply for Free School Meals & Pupil Premium Funding

1. Google Nottinghamshire County Council Citizen Portal or follow this link:

2. Log in using the username and password you created to apply for a school place.
3. Next, click on the Free School Meals button which will allow you to complete your application.
