




Transport is a vehicle that takes people or goods from one place to another.


Different types of transports are suitable for different journeys.

The boat was the **first** type of transport. Over time, new inventions have made boat journeys faster and safer

Boats can be powered by people, engines, wind, or the sun. ·




An engine is the part of a vehicle that produces power to make it move.

Lesson 4: How were the first trains different from today?



Diesel is an oil that powers engines.



Rail tracks were around a long time before trains. Wagons were pulled along rails by horses.

In **1804**, Richard Trevithick put a steam engine on rail tracks for the first time. The first steam trains were called **locomotives**. They transported coal, not people.

In **1825**, an inventor called George Stephenson drove the first passenger locomotive from Stockton to Darlington.

Most trains today are powered by electricity or diesel.

Omnibus- horse drawn carriage for 10 passengers




Karl Benz made the first petrol powered car in 1886.



Early cars and buses were different from cars today. The invention of cars and buses made journeys **easier**. Buses and cars have changed over time.

Over time, bicycles have become **safer**, more **comfortable**, and **easier** to use.
