KIRF Summer 2: Know multiplication and division facts for 5x table

This half term, children will be learning the multiplication and division facts for the 5 times table. Developing quick recall of these facts helps children build confidence with number patterns and prepares them for more complex multiplication and division later on.

Multiplication:	Division:
$1 \times 5 = 5$	$5 \div 5 = 1$
$2 \times 5 = 10$	$10 \div 5 = 2$
$3 \times 5 = 15$	$15 \div 5 = 3$
$4 \times 5 = 20$	$20 \div 5 = 4$
$5 \times 5 = 25$	$25 \div 5 = 5$
$6 \times 5 = 30$	$30 \div 5 = 6$
$7 \times 5 = 35$	$35 \div 5 = 7$
$8 \times 5 = 40$	$40 \div 5 = 8$
$9 \times 5 = 45$	$45 \div 5 = 9$
$10 \times 5 = 50$	$50 \div 5 = 10$
$11 \times 5 = 55$	$55 \div 5 = 11$
$12 \times 5 = 60$	$60 \div 5 = 12$

How you can help at home

Multiplication Questions

- What is 5×4 ?
- What is 7 groups of 5?
- What is 10×5 ?
- What comes next in the 5 times table?

Division Questions

- What is $20 \div 5$?
- How many groups of 5 make 35?
- If I share 25 into groups of 5, how many groups are there?

Counting and Grouping

- Count in 5s while walking or clapping
- Group toys into sets of 5
- Count coins in 5p pieces

Games and Activities

- Chant the 5 times table together
- Use flashcards for quick recall
- Ask quick-fire questions during car journeys
