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

**High quality Literacy program:** Talk 4 Writing is a evidenced driven, multi-sensory approach to teaching writing that empowers children to internalise language structures through oral storytelling, leading to confident, independent, and creative writing across all genres.

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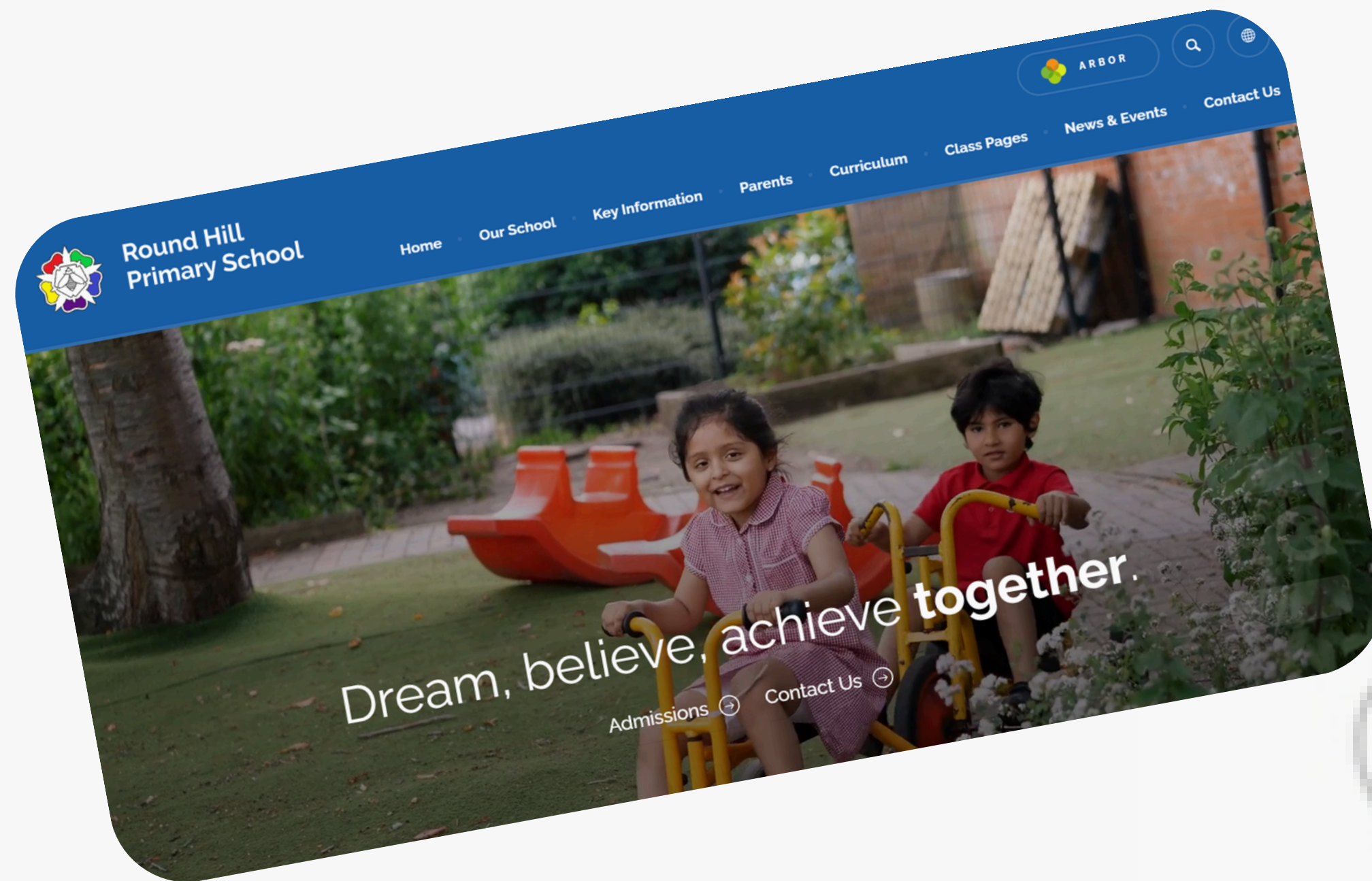

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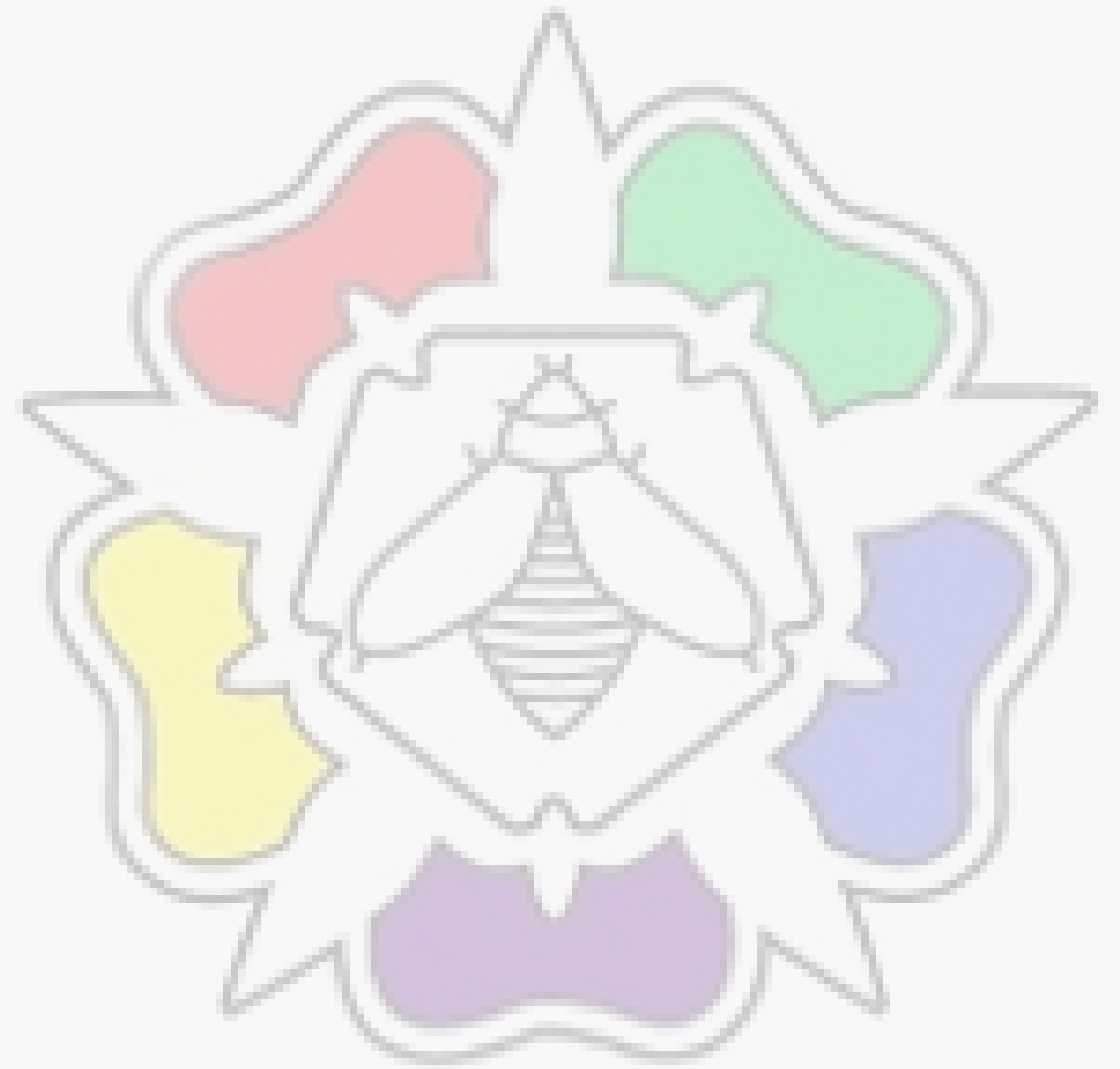
