Experienced staff from the NST are on hand to offer guidance, support, useful strategies, information, and answer questions. Each session there will be a theme subject for group discussion.

Occasionally there will be a guest speaker, and the scheduled themed group discussion may be rearranged.

Due to the organisation of the group, please do not bring children.

This will enable you to participate in the discussions with parents and our practitioner. We cannot offer supervision, also we need to consider the confidentiality of other families and the health and safety for everyone in the meeting.

No booking or diagnosis required. **IMPORTANT-** Due to adverse weather conditions, over winter, the group may be cancelled at short notice. Occasionally group dates may be rescheduled so check the latest NST Newsletter for upcoming dates.
