New Music Tuition Requests for the Next School Year: September 2026 - July 2027

The information in this letter is for all parents/carers whose child is currently in Year 3, 4 or 5 and who would like to start learning a musical instrument in school in September 2026. If your child already has music lessons in school, you do not need to complete this form and we will be contacting you separately regarding their lessons for the next school year.

Thank you to those of you who were able to join us at our Music Information Meeting on 10th June, it was great to see so many families in school. This letter talks about the next steps if you wish to apply for your child to play an instrument. If you would like to apply for your child to have music lessons in school during the 2026-27 school year, please click on the below form. The deadline to complete this form is the end of the day on **Friday, 3rd July 2026**.

Lessons take place during the school day in groups of two or three or you can request an individual lesson for your child. Pupils will find out what day and time their lessons will be once the timetables have been finalised by the music teachers.

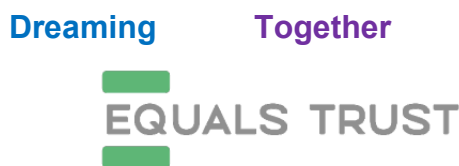
Most of the music lessons are provided by teachers from Inspire Music who work with Nottinghamshire County Council. These teachers cover the following instruments:

- Woodwind: flute, clarinet, and saxophone
- Strings: violin
- Keyboard

In addition, we have four independent music teachers who teach the following instruments:

- Guitar – please note that we will have a new guitar teacher in September for new pupils as our current teacher will be teaching his current pupils only and cannot take on any more pupils
- Drums
- Piano
- Brass: french horn, cornet, trumpet and trombone

The current cost of the shared music lessons through Inspire is a termly cost of £80.64 (this is subject to a slight increase for the next academic year) for a minimum of 10 lessons per term. These lessons are either for 2 children, lasting for 20 minutes or for 3 children, lasting for 30 minutes. This equates to 30 lessons during the school year. However, there are 35 Inspire teaching weeks and therefore it may be the case that your child receives 35 lessons during the academic year whilst you will be charged for 30. Should you be interested in your child having a 20-minute individual lesson then this is double the cost of the shared lesson.



Instruments may be hired from Inspire (all apart from keyboard). The charge for this is currently £22.70 per term. It is a requirement that you are covered under your home insurance for the instrument. All these charges are waived by Inspire for children in receipt of free school meals.

As a school we have to confirm how many children will be learning an instrument and we are charged for that number of children termly. It is for this reason that we have to ask that you and your child commit to the full school year of music tuition.

Lessons for drums, guitar, brass and piano are organised directly between yourselves and the independent tutors. If your child is interested in learning one of these instruments, please complete the form and we will ask the teachers to contact you directly via e-mail. They will be able to confirm their charges to you.
