Dear Parents/Carers

Class Arrangements for 2026–27

This letter outlines our planned class arrangements for the 2026-27 academic year, along with useful guidance to help support your child as they prepare for the changes ahead - whether they are moving to a new class in September or leaving Round Hill to begin secondary school. At Round Hill, we follow a well-established transition programme designed to help children feel confident, secure and positive about change. This includes opportunities to discuss their feelings, explore any worries, and take part in transition activities such as Class Swap Morning, where they can meet their new teacher and become familiar with their new environment.

Following feedback from parents, we are sharing your child’s new class slightly earlier this year. You will receive an email on **Thursday 25th June** letting you know your child’s class for September 2026 so you can talk to your child about the upcoming change. We hope this will give you time to begin supportive conversations with your child, focusing on the positives of change and helping them to feel excited and reassured about the year ahead. The [school website](#) has lots of tips on how you can support your child to prepare for the transition to next year. If you have any specific concerns, please feel free to speak with your child’s teacher **after** the Class Swap Morning has taken place **on Wednesday 1st July 2026**. From our experience, nearly all children have a positive transition when we work together to support them.

The transition events planned aim to ensure your child is able to complete the current year and then settle well when they return in the autumn term. All of the below dates are on the school website already, but please make a note of these dates in your diary:

Wednesday 1st July 2026 9.00 a.m. - 12.00 p.m.	Class Swap Morning	Children will spend the morning with their new class and teacher. <i>(Year 6 have their own transition arrangements)</i>	To help you prepare your child, we will be sharing your child’s new class, via email, on Thursday 25 th June, so you can talk to them about the upcoming change.
Tuesday 14th July 2026 3.35 p.m. - 4.45 p.m. <i>Last entry will be 4.30 pm.</i>	After School Open Afternoon and Meet the New Teacher <i>(the format of this event has been changed from last year so please read it carefully)</i>	This event is mainly aimed at parents with children in EYFS to Year 5 (i.e. Years 1-6 as of September 2026) and will provide information relating to your child’s transition to their new class.	This is a drop-in session between 3.35 p.m. and 4.45 p.m. and does not have appointment times. The PowerPoints we use will be posted on the school website on Monday 13 th July. Collect your child in the normal way and make your way to your child’s new classroom from the playground. If you are arriving after 3.45 pm, when the gates are locked, then please enter through the main entrance.

Thank you for your ongoing support in helping ensure your child’s smooth transition to their new class or school.
