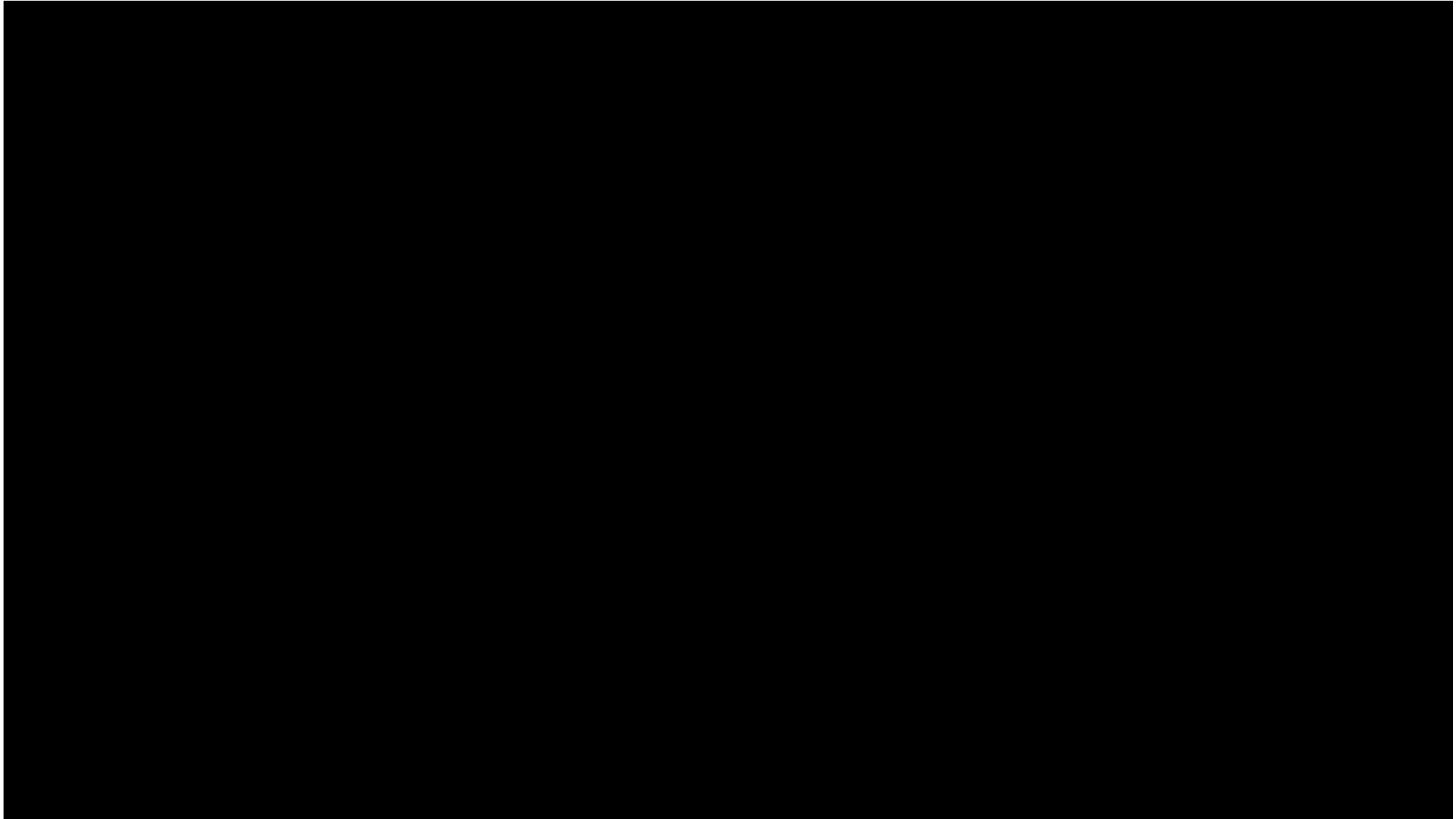


## Summary of Music at Round Hill

## How it Works

- Lessons are during the school day.
- Same time each week.
- 20 minute shared lesson with another pupil or a 20 minute individual lesson.
- 1 year commitment due to various contracts.



## **Cost of Lessons**

### **Independent Music Teachers**

- Guitar, piano, drums and brass
- Costs shared directly by the teacher
- Payments made directly to the teacher

### **Inspire Music**

- Woodwind, strings, keyboard
- £80.64 per term – 20-minute shared lesson
- £161.28 per term – 20-minute individual lesson
- Minimum of 10 lessons per term
- Instrument hire: £22.70 per term
- Invoices sent via Arbor at the end of each term
- Free for pupils eligible for free school meals
