Annual Report 2025–26

We are pleased to share your child's Annual Report for the academic year 2025–26.

The following year groups have statutory assessment data included in Arbor:

- **EYFS** – EYFS Profile
- **Year 1** – Phonics Screening Check
- **Year 2** – Phonics Screening Check (retake, if applicable*)
- **Year 4** – Multiplication Tables Check

- **Year 6** – *End of Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessments (SATs). Usually at this stage of the year, the Year 6 SATs results would have been published. You may have seen in the press that these results have been delayed until later in July. As soon as we have these results, they will also be available in Arbor for you to view.*

We hope you are pleased with your child's report. Please remember to save an electronic copy or print a paper copy for your records, as we cannot guarantee access to previous years' reports. You may find it easier to open the [Arbor Parent Portal](#) on a computer as this makes it easier to download a report and print – using the Quick Actions tab, select Report Cards.

If you have any questions after reading the report, there will be an opportunity to discuss this in person during our **Open Afternoon** on **Tuesday 14th July, 3:35 p.m. – 4:45 p.m.** (*Note: Last entry will be 4.30 p.m.*) The Class Arrangements letter dated 23rd June advised that the format of this event has changed from last year. This event is mainly aimed at parents with children in EYFS to Year 5 (i.e. Years 1-6 as of September 2026) and will provide information relating to your child's transition to their new class. This is a **drop-in session** between 3.35 p.m. and 4.45 p.m. and does **not** have appointment times. The PowerPoints we use will be posted on the school website on Monday 13th July.

Our teachers invest a great deal of time and care in preparing these reports, and we hope you find them both informative and reflective of your child's progress.
